Valletta is the capital of Malta and a World Heritage site. It is a monument of Baroque architecture built by the Knights of St John five centuries ago.

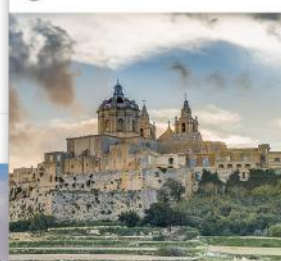
The Three Cities were home to the Knights of Malta.
