



FAQ



Dealing with visas can be a little confusing so we've gathered our most frequently asked questions and their answers to help make the process easier.

- Is there a time limit to apply for the visa extension?

Yes, 8 weeks (60 days). You need to apply when you have 4 weeks left on your current visa. Visa Unit can refuse your application.

- Can I take holidays in my last week of studies?

No. It is illegal for language schools to give holidays during the last week of the course.

- Do I need to bring all my bank account transactions report?

No. A simple letter from the bank with the account balance is enough.

- How much money do I need to have to apply for an extension?

If your accommodation is at DIH, THH or homestay you need 25 EUR a day for the whole stay.
If you are on private accommodation, you need 48 EUR a day for the whole stay.

- Do I need insurance?

Yes, you need a medical insurance that covers the whole period.

- Can I travel after my course ends?

No. Your visa extension is a student visa extension that finishes with the last day of your course and you will have 3 days to leave the EU. If you wish to travel, you can do it before your course finish, but not during the last week.

- I am in private accommodation, how can I prove my address?

You need a rental contract signed by the owner of the flat/house and a Rental Declaration Form signed by the landlord and yourself.

- How many holidays can I take?

For stays longer than 4 months, you get 4 weeks holidays. These are not to be taken on the last week of your course and not all together.
